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History of Summer Lodge

Summer Lodge is a fine Georgian listed house in the picturesque village of Evershot, West Dorset. This privately owned Relais and Châteaux English country house hotel set in four acres, offers facilities such as a croquet lawn, all-weather tennis court and award-winning restaurant, as well as Gym and Sauna, a mini spa and heated indoor pool. The hotel adjoins a 9000 acre deer park offering excellent walking and an abundance of wildlife and flowers throughout the year.

Summer Lodge was built in 1798 as a dower house by the 2nd Earl of Ilchester. The country seat of the Earls of Ilchester is Melbury House on the outskirts of Evershot. In 1893, the property was enlarged and a second floor added by the 6th Earl who commissioned his friend and local author, Thomas Hardy, (an architect by profession) to draw up the plans. The house was further modernised in 1932 by the last Earl to live in Dorset, when as Lord Stavordale, he brought his bride to live at Summer Lodge. His London home was Holland House in Kensington.

When Margaret and Nigel Corbett purchased the property in 1979, they became only the second owners in nearly two centuries. At that time, the 12 bed-roomed property with dilapidated outbuildings, had been empty for 3 years. Within 7 weeks, they had converted Summer Lodge into a hotel and their private home – with eight bedrooms. The first guests paid £10.50 for dinner, bed and breakfast.

In 1988, the stables and coach house were converted into bedrooms and an all-weather tennis court and heated pool were added. In 1991, the Dining Room was enlarged and remodelled to compliment the Thomas Hardy designed Drawing Room with its full length sash windows. The hotel became a member of Relais and Châteaux.

In 1995, the entire cast of 'Sense and Sensibility' stayed at Summer Lodge while filming at nearby Montacute House – Hugh Laurie, Imelda Staunton, Emma Thompson, Alan Rickman, Kate Winslet, Hugh Grant and Imogen Stubbs.

In 1996, while scenes from 'Emma' were being shot in Evershot, its stars Gwyneth Paltrow and Toni Colette were the guests of Summer Lodge.

In 2003, Red Carnation Hotels of London purchased the hotel and embarked on an extensive renovation. This included the addition of a mini spa, the enclosure of the heated swimming pool in a climate-controlled conservatory, the incorporation of Ivy Cottage (7 Fore Street) and The Summer Lane Cottages, and new offices, staff quarters.

Glenmorangie Collection, Highlands (35ml)

Legend tells that alcoholic beverages of one kind or another were produced in and around Tain since the Middle-Ages. The Sixteen Men of Tain, to whom the bottle refers, are also widely believed to be the source and origin of the popular "Highlander" film and television series. Scottish legend states that the Sixteen Men of Tain took part in an epic battle that left only one man of

Tain standing. This, of course, happened after they perfected the distillation process. It is said that the production of alcohol started at Morangie Farm in 1738, when a brewery was built that shared the farm's water source, the Tarlogie Spring. A former distillery manager, William Matheson, acquired the farm in 1843 and converted the Morangie brewery to a distillery, equipped with two second hand gin stills. He later renamed the distillery Glenmorangie.

Islands

It is a source of constant debate whether Orkney belongs to the Islands or in fact should be counted as part of the Highlands region. Whisky from the Islands may be described as a milder version of Islay whisky and is often appreciated by those who have enjoyed whisky for a few years.

Irish (35ml)

Some differences exist between Irish Whiskey and Scotch Whisky. Not all barley used in Irish whisky is malted. Together with the fact that Irish malt generally is dried without the use of peat or any other smoke, Irish whiskey allows more of the natural flavours of the barley to rise to the front than Scotch whisky. Because it is triple distilled, Irish whiskey also has a softer, more rounded flavour than its Scottish counterpart. The Irish pot stills are larger than Scottish stills.

Because of the fact that almost all Bourbon is made in Kentucky many people believe this is a requirement, but in fact Bourbon may be produced in any state. The only prerequisites are that it must be made in the US, contain at least 51 percent corn and that it must be stored for at least two years in new, charred oak barrels. Lastly, the raw spirit may not be distilled to more than 80 percent alcohol by volume.

The history of the Japanese whisky Hanyu dates back to the 1600s, with the Akuto family producing sake in the town of Chichibu. Many years later, in 1941, the company built a factory in Hanyu and received their licence to produce alcohol in 1946, under the eyes of Isouji Akuto. It was here that they started to produce whisky in the 1980s, and in the 1990s they released a single malt whisky. Sadly, production stopped in 2000 and was finally closed in 2004. However, the story of Hanyu doesn't stop there. While much of the distillery was dismantled, Ichiro Akuto (Isouji's grandson) managed to purchase the remaining stocks of Hanyu whisky with plans to sell them - and he did just that, with the Ichiro's Malt releases and the much adored Ichiro's Malt Card series. Following this, Ichiro opened the Chichibu distillery in 2008.

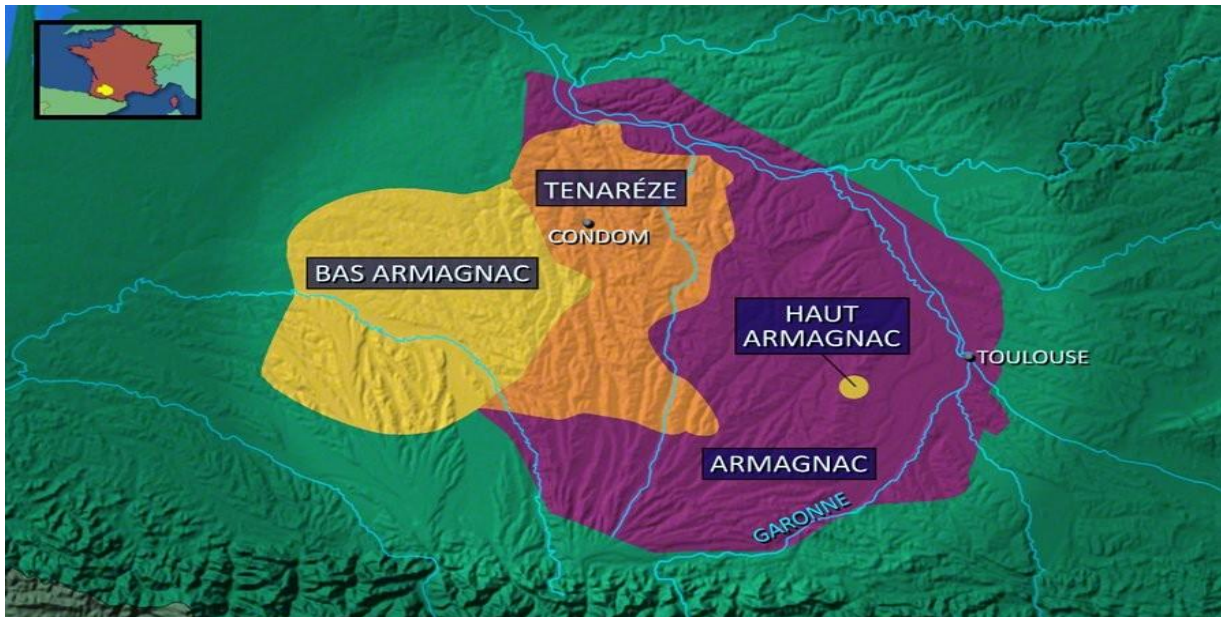

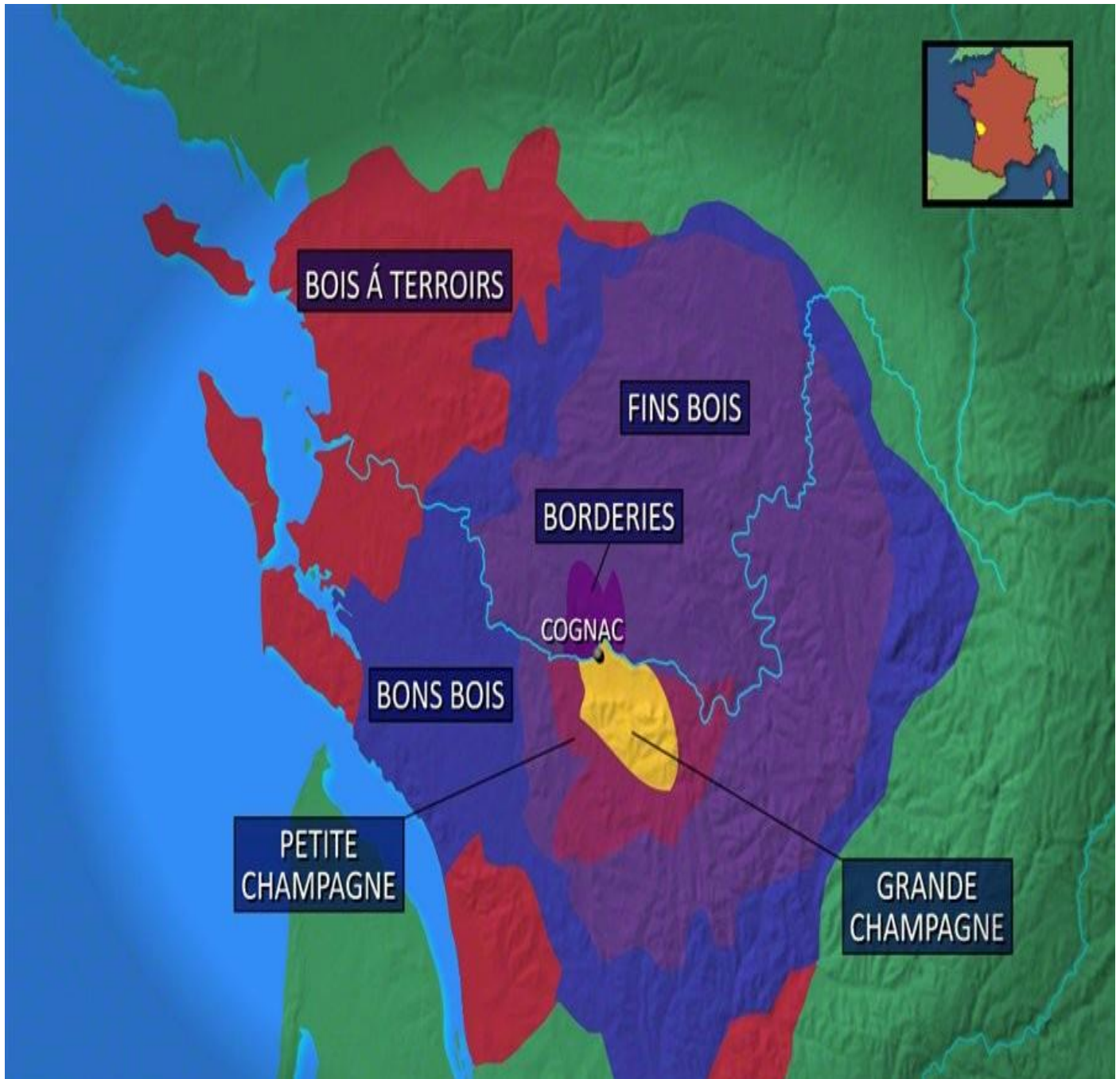
Armagnac, is truly the most noble and most ancient brandies. The still originally introduced by the Arabs was first used in the region in 1411 and from that year the “Alchemist Recipes” a famous manuscript in the Auch describes some thirty uses of brandy as medicine. Thus was born Armagnac. And this is why the Darroze family had their alcohols distilled on their various estates with a mobile still and always by the same “bouilleur de cru”. All Darroze Armagnac’s are distilled using this method, traditional in the region for over 150 years and come out of the still at between 52-54% alcohol by volume. Francis Darroze started his business in 1974 as a trader and a producer of vintage Bas-Armagnacs. The initial concept was simple: to create awareness of a region and its extraordinarily varied wine-producing soils, while respecting the originality and typical nature of each estate. Since then he has intensified his search for the best vineyards and the best soils in Bas-Armagnac and sourced from a golden triangle of villages comprising, amongst others, Labastide-Armagnac, Arthez, Villeneuve-de-Marsan, le Bourdalat, Lacquy, Perquie, Hontanx, and Le Houga.

The brandies are tasted and assessed frequently in their infancy. After 12-15 years of ageing the alcohols are generally decanted into older barrels which will soften them and provide noticeable viscosity. The total ageing process, which can last forty to fifty years demands a lot of patience. To preserve the identity of the product and to respect the characteristics of the soil, climate and varietals, Armagnacs are never blended together – even two casks from the same domaine. Darroze refuse to blend vintages either. The final measure to preserve authenticity and ensure purity is that the spirits are always allowed to reduce naturally rather by adding water (which is a perfectly legal process in the region).

The domaine offers about 45 vintages dating back to the beginning of the 19th century. In the Armagnac region, when a product is sold under its original vintage, the law imposes a minimum ageing period of 10 years in oak casks. The desired balance between tannin, flavour and alcohol is, in fact, reached after 15 years. Darroze Armagnacs are kept in barrel and bottled to order to ensure the maximum beneficial interaction between oak and brandy. After 15 years ageing Armagnac develops all the qualities which make it an inimitable brandy. A blend of gentleness and violence, these Armagnacs have an extremely long lasting aftertaste. The flavours of hazelnut, orange peel, cocoa and quince combine with the aromas of rose, verbena, leather, vanilla and even cinnamon. These Armagnacs have a body and fullness which exalt the land. After 25 years, Armagnac brandy loses its strength, softens, and becomes mellow, very smooth. The original character is diluted by the oak vat. The aftertaste becomes remarkable, noticeable over a day later, suppleness and elegance definitively taking over from warmth.

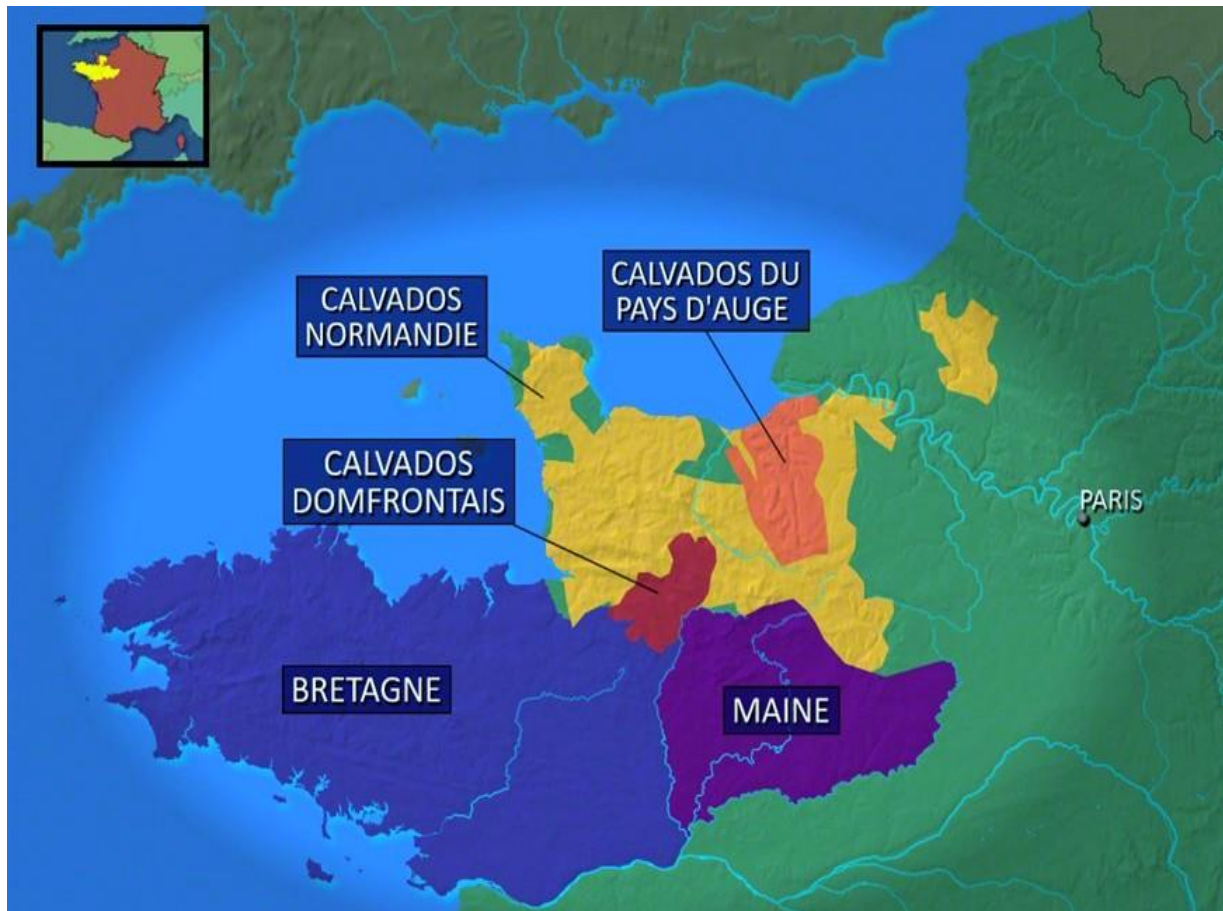
