It is a 125-hectare property and currently has only 22 hectares under vine. The rest is a wildlife conservancy dedicated to the amazing bio-dynamic ‘fynbos’ flora the Western Cape is renowned for. They have been passionately dedicated to making wines of outstanding style and quality ever since their inception. The Tollman family acquired the estate in the year 2000 and made an immediate impact lifting Bouchard Finlayson wines onto the global stage.
